This acknowledges your letter regarding the recent decision of the State Tax Commission in your case, and a notice and demand issued to Claire Jahn dated September 14, 1971.

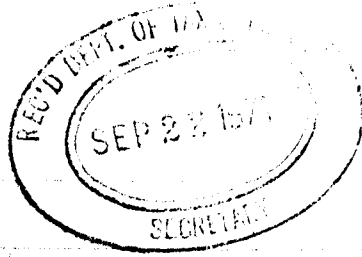
