


ORDERED that the petition of Hans G. Litschke and Anita Litschke be and the same is hereby denied.

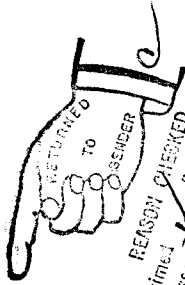
