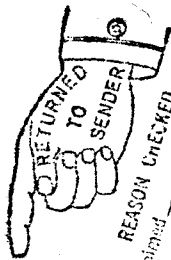



Now on motion of the attorney for the Department of Taxation and Finance, it is

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
ORDERED that the petition of William M. and Grace I. Curtis
