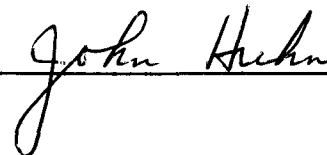

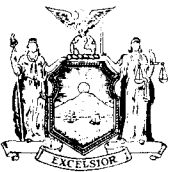

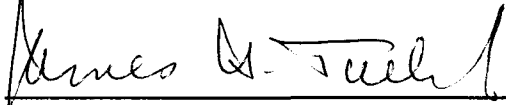

not appear at the pre-hearing conference . A default has been duly noted.

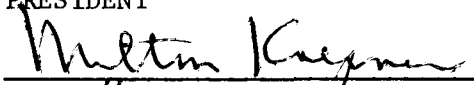

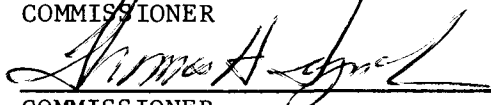
